

COUNTY OF ST. PAUL NO. 19

BY-LAW NO. 1308

A By-Law of the County of St. Paul #19 in the Province of Alberta to authorize the provision of Provincial E-911 services to be provided to the County of St. Paul No. 19.

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 54 of the Municipal Government Act, a municipality may provide any service or thing that is provided in all or part of the municipality in another municipal authority with the agreement of the other municipal authority.

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, a Council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property.

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19 wishes to provide Provincial E-911 service within the Municipality and enter into agreements with other agencies and/or municipalities to provide such service.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19 duly assembled and acts as follows:

1. The County of St. Paul No. 19 will enter into an agreement with Telus Communications Inc. to provide access to emergency service: via its Provincial E-911 service.
2. The County of St. Paul No. 19 will enter into an agreement with the Strathcona County to provide the E-911 Call Answer Services.
3. The County of St. Paul No. 19 will enter into an agreement with Telus Communications Inc. in order that Telus will act as a billing and collecting agent for the Call Answer Service.
4. A customer within the County of St. Paul No. 19 who subscribes 'i Telus' Exchange Service will be provided with the E-911 service and be required to pay fees for said service.
5. This By-law shall take effect on the day of its final passing thereof.
