By-Law No. 1127

A By-Law of the County of St. Paul No. 19 in the Province of Alberta to control Field Scabious.

WHEREAS Field Scabious is not classified as a designated weed under the regulations of the Provincial Weed Control Act and there is no present means that a landowner can be compelled to control these plants growing on his or her property, and

WHEREAS these plants have started spreading in a small area onto Agricultural land, it is a concern of the Agricultural Service Board of the County of St. Paul No. 19 to have Field Scabious controlled to prevent the further spread of it,

THEREFORE be it resolved that under By-Law 1127, the County of St. Paul No. 19 requests that Field Scabious (*Knautia Arvensis*) be designated as a noxious weed in the County of St. Paul No. 19.

Read a second time the 14th day of April, 1987

Read a third time and finally passed this 14th day April, 1987.
