

COUNTY OF ST. PAUL NO. 19

BY-LAW NO. 1340

A Bylaw of the County of St. Paul No. 19 in the Province of Alberta, to establish the administrative structure of the County of St. Paul No. 19 in relation to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, and to set fees thereunder.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 89 of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, S.A. 1994, c.F-18.5, the County of St. Paul No. 19 must designate a person or group of persons as the head of the Municipality for the purposes of the Act;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 87 and 89 of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, the County of St. Paul No. 19 may set any fees payable to the Municipality for services under the Act and Regulations;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19 duly assembled, enacts as follows:

PART 1 - PURPOSE AND DEFINITIONS

Section 1

- a) This Bylaw is cited as “**Administrative Structure and Fee Schedule Bylaw**” of the County of St. Paul No. 19.

Section 2

- a) In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:

“**Act**” means the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, S.A. 1994, c.F-18.5, as amended;

“**Applicant**” means a person who makes a request for access to a record under section 7(1) of the Act;

“**Municipality**” means the County of St. Paul No. 19 and includes any board, committee, commission, panel, agency or corporation that is created or owned by the County of St. Paul No. 19 and all the members or officers of which are appointed or chosen by the County of St. Paul No. 19;

“**County Administrator**” means the person appointed as the County Administrator of the County of St. Paul No. 19, and includes any person who holds the position of the County Administrator in Acting capacity;

“**Province**” means the Province of Alberta.

PART 2 - DESIGNATED HEAD

Section 3

- a) For the purposes of the Act, the County Administrator is designated as the Freedom of Information and Privacy Head of the Municipality.

PART 3 - FEES

- a) Where an Applicant is required to pay a fee for services, the fee payable is in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulation as amended that sets fees for requests for information from the Province.

PART 4 - ENACTMENT

- a) This Bylaw shall come into force and have affect upon it being read a third time and passed.
