

COUNTY OF ST. PAUL NO. 19

BY-LAW NO. 1532

A By-law to amend Land Use Bylaw No. 1486 of the County of St. Paul No. 19, in the Province of Alberta.

WHEREAS, the Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19 deems it reasonable to review it's Land Use Bylaw;

NOW, THEREFORE, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, 2000, as amended, and by virtue of all other powers it enabling, the Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19, hereby assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Land Use Bylaw No. 1486, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

8.3. COUNTRY RESIDENTIAL ONE (CR1) DISTRICT

4. REGULATIONS

Amend Section 5(c) to read as follows:

(5) Recreational Vehicles

- (c) Notwithstanding Subsections (a) and (b) above, no development permit shall be required for the placement of **two (2)** recreational vehicles on a lot for any time period, provided that that recreational vehicle remains mobile, and has no accessory buildings or structures associated with it.

Read a first time in Council this 9th day of June, A.D. 2009.

Read a second time in Council this 14th day of July, A.D. 2009.
