MUNICIPAL PARK REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations have been approved by resolution of County Council.
Park Managers are responsible to implement and enforce them.

Everyone entering the campsite must check into the Park Office.

Campsite Regulations

Please obey posted speed limits.

Quiet time between 11:00 pm and 8:00 am

Zero tolerance for excessive noise.

Main gate will be closed and locked between 11:00 pm and 8:00 am (In case of an emergency, please contact the on duty park attendant). Gate will only be opened in the case of emergency.

No fireworks in park area.

Dogs are not allowed around beach and playground areas and must be leashed at all times.

Off highway vehicles and ATV's are not permitted in the park.

The cutting of trees is strictly prohibited.

Any act of vandalism will result in immediate expulsion from the park.

Shower facilities are for registered campers only. The use of shower facilities for the general public is strictly prohibited.

Campers may book up to a maximum of 14 days. Monthly stalls are no longer available.

Septic tanks can only be emptied using a septic caddy or bringing the trailer to the dumping station.

No septic trucks allowed for personal use.

Use your generators with respect. Personal generator use is limited from 8:00 am to 11:00 pm. Park manager has the right to ask that a generator be turned off or moved to a location where you are not disturbing adjacent campers.

Check out time is 2:00 pm.

Absolutely no refunds.

Day Use Area Regulations

All people who require a Picnic Table must register at the park office.

Day Use Area Hours: 10:00 am to 8:00 pm. Closing times may change without notice.

No alcohol permitted in day use area.

Firewood

There will be a \$10.00 charge for a wheelbarrow of firewood.

Please conserve the use of firewood by not having

- 1) Excessively large fires
- 2) Fires burning while no one at site

Reservation Policy

Reservations will not be accepted before May 1st (or the first Monday of May) for the current camping season.

Reservations are on a first come first served basis.

Absolutely no reservations will be made without a Credit Card number.

48 Hour Cancellation Policy is in effect. If 48 hours notice is not given, a one day charge will be applied to your credit card.

If wishing to book after your maximum 14 day stay, you may book the same stall, providing that stall is not already reserved for someone else. This inquiry can only be made on the last day of your stay. You may move directly to another stall, if available.

Campsite Fees

Stoney Lake, Lac Bellevue or Floatingstone Lake: Day Use Area: \$2.00 per person over 12 years old when using the picnic area and \$20.00/night for Powered Sites, \$15.00/night for Non Powered Sites. **Westcove:** Day Use Area: \$2.00 per person and \$25.00/night for Powered Sites, \$20.00/night for Non Powered Sites.

Small Gazebo: \$50.00 per day

Large Gazebo: \$75.00 per day

Upon registration, payments must be paid in full for your entire stay.

Park Managers have been given direction from County Council to enforce the above rules and regulations. Campers not following these rules and regulations may be evicted.
