Where is it? From St. Paul travel north on Hwy 881. Turn west on Township Road 590, then north on Range Road 100.

All Summer Long in the County of St. Paul

Our municipal campgrounds are located 2 hours east of Edmonton and within a half hour of the Town of St. Paul.

Inviting sandy beaches to enjoy on a hot summer day ... so relaxing! Stay for the day, for a week or longer.



Floating Stone Lake Campground is a naturally wooded area abutting the south shore of the lake. The park is maintained and groomed to ensure its natural beauty.

- * On-site: 65 powered stalls/19 nonpowered stalls, dumping station and sewage disposal. Sites 53 to 65 are new, larger and non-powered
- * Recreation: Swimming, fishing, beaches, boat launch, playgrounds, free Wi-Fi
- * Firewood is available for sale
- * Large gazebo, located on the beach

Where is it? From Ashmont travel west on Hwy 28. Turn north on Range Rd 120 for 8 km, then turn right on Township Road 603.



Lac Bellevue is a naturally sheltered spot offering the ultimate for the family camper. All amenities are nestled closed together. Enjoy your campsite while watching the children on the playground or on the spacious beach area.

- * On-site: 20 powered stalls/14 non-powered stalls
- * Recreation: Spacious beach, beach volleyball, playground, boat launch, fishing, swimming, free Wi-Fi
- * Firewood is available for sale
- * Large Gazebo near the beach

Where is it? From St. Paul travel east on Hwy 29 for 1 mile. Turn south on Hwy 881 to Township Road 562. Turn west for 3 miles, then south for 1 mile.



Stoney Lake Campground offers the ultimate in camping with total privacy between large stalls in this undisturbed wooded area.

The natural topography segregates the camping area from the beach and activity area.

- * On-site: 45 powered stalls, sewage disposal
- * Recreation: Day use area, beach area, beach volleyball, playground area, new boat launch, swimming, fishing, free Wi-Fi
- * Firewood is available for sale
- * Gazebo located on the beach

Where is it? From St. Paul travel east on Hwy 29 for 1 mile. Turn south on Hwy 881. Turn east on Hwy 646 and then turn south on Range Road 81A.
