

BY-LAW #1087

COUNTY OF ST. PAUL #19

A By-Law of the County of St. Paul No. 19 in the Province of Alberta for the controlling of vehicles parking on County roads in the County of St. Paul No. 19 for the purpose of loading tanks with water.

WHEREAS the Council of the County of St. Paul NO. 19 considers that parking on County roads for the purpose of loading tanks with water unsafe and hazardous to the travelling public, and also causing damage to the roads,

THEREFORE, under Section 172 (3) of the Municipal Government Act, (Part 5), the Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19 orders:

"That parking of water tankers on any County of St. Paul No 19 roads for the purpose of loading water from sloughs, ditches or any other source of supply is prohibited."

Anyone charged and convicted of contravening this By-Law shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$100.00 for the first offence and not more than \$200.00 for any subsequent offence under this By-Law, or failing payment of same, a prison term of up to 6 months.

This By-Law shall come into force upon date of passing.

READ the first time the 13 of August, 1985
