

COUNTY OF ST. PAUL NO. 19

BY-LAW NO. 1180

A By-Law of the County of St. Paul No. 19 in the Province of Alberta authorizing the implementation of road bans on highways within the County.

WHEREAS, the Minister of Transportation has, pursuant to Subsection 14(1) of the Motor Transport Act, being Chapter M-20 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, as amended, authorized the County Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19 ("the County") to exercise the powers specified in Section 14 of the said Motor Transport Act including the implementation of road bans;

AND WHEREAS the County, in accordance with Subsection 14 (3) of the said Motor Transport Act, deems it advisable to establish a Committee and to delegate to that Committee the authority to exercise the powers specified in Section 14 of the said Motor Transport Act;

NOW THEREFORE the County Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. words used in this By-Law have the same meaning as words used or defined in the said Motor Transport Act.
2. The County Public Works Superintendent has full power and authority to:
 - (a) prohibit the use of a secondary road, rural road or street by a traction engine or public vehicle, or by a class or classes thereof, for a period or periods that the Committee determines,
 - (b) limit or restrict the speed of a traction engine or public vehicle, or of a class or classes thereof, using a secondary road, rural road or street, for a period or periods that the Committee determines, and
 - (c) increase, limit or restrict the maximum gross weight that may be borne by a tire, an axle or an axle group, or any of them, or the maximum gross weight that may be borne by a vehicle or combination of vehicles on a secondary road or street for a period or periods that the Committee determines.
3. The Public works Superintendent shall cause signs to be erected along the secondary road or rural road, as the Public works Superintendent considers necessary to notify persons using the road of the prohibition, limitation, increase or restriction imposed.
4. This By-Law shall take effect as and from the third and final reading.
