COUNTY OF ST. PAUL NO. 19

BY-LAW NO. 1314

A By-law of the County of St. Paul No. 19 in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of closing to public travel, creating title to and disposing of portions of a public highway in accordance with section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26.1, Revised Statutes of Alberta 1994, as amended.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the highway closed, and

WHEREAS the Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19 deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to and disposing of same, and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT **RESOLVED** that the Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19 in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel, create title to and dispose of the following described highways, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

PLAN 867CL

- 1. 2nd Avenue
- 2. 20 foot lane in Block 1 SW of the South Limit of First Avenue
- 3. All that portion of First Street East which lies SW of the SE production of the South limit of First Avenue
