BY-LAW NO. 927

COUNTY OF ST. PAUL #19

A By-Law of the County of St. Paul No. 19 in the Province of Alberta, to control development adjacent to Municipal roads.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 42 of the Public Highways Development ACT RSA. 1970 which permits Council to enact by-laws to prevent the creation of hazards to traffic.

WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient to pass a by-law pursuant to Section 42 of the Public Highways Development Act.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the County of St. Paul #19 duly assembled enacts as follows:

No person may create a hazard to traffic on any roadway by excavation of rock, earth or other material adjacent to the roadway within two hundred feet, measured on the surface, from the centre line of a roadway, subject to the direction, control or management of the County of St. Paul #19, without prior approval of the Council.
