Highlights May 14, 2019 Council Meeting

2019 Property Tax Notices – were mailed on May 10. If you do not receive your notice, contact Carolyn at 645-3301, ext. 215 to ensure that the County has your correct mailing address on file.

Tax Rate Bylaw – Council approved the 2019 Tax Rate Bylaw. Based on the requirements of the 2019 capital and operational budget, Council has increased the municipal tax rate on residential properties by 0.25. Other municipal tax rates remain unchanged. Residential properties did, in some cases, see decreases to assessment based on decreases in market values. As the County has not received the School Requisition from the Province, the school tax was estimated with an overall increase of \$11,673. If the requisition from the Province is different than the estimated amount, the 2020 school mill rate will be adjusted accordingly.

Fundraising Opportunity for Non-Profit Organizations – The County is looking for a group to assist with clean up after the rodeo performances. The group will work with another group selected by the Town of St. Paul and will receive a \$1250 honorarium from the Town of St. Paul. The group who cleans after the rodeo performances this year will then work the rodeo supper in 2020 and receive all the proceeds from the supper (estimated \$2700 to \$3300). Municipal Parks – Council approved a Parks Bylaw 2019-09, a set of rules governing access to and conduct within Municipal Parks. MCSNet Fiber Optic line to Hamlet of Mallaig – Council approved an agreement permitting Buried Glass Inc. to install the fiber optic line in the County Right-of-Way. In exchange, the County will receive free internet servicing to the Mallaig Fire Hall and the Mallaig Water Treatment Plant for 60 months.
