Temporary Recycling at Elk Point Transfer Station – Quik Pick Waste Disposal and Blue Wave Recycling Services has set up a temporary recycling service at the Elk Point Transfer Station, as a pilot project. They have supplied containers for clean cardboard, clean recyclable plastics and newspaper and will monitor the volume of materials recycled at this site. Residents are encouraged to use this recycling service.

Planning and Development – The County will enter into an encroachment agreement with the owners of Lot 7, Block 1, Plan 8020711 at Lac Sante to accommodate the portion of their deck that was inadvertently built on the environmental reserve property in front of their cottage back in 1988.

FCSS – Will be holding Drive in Movie Nights on July 22 – Boscombe, July 23 – Lac Bellevue Hall, August 10 – Stoney Lake, August 12 – Heinsburg, August 13 – Lac Bellevue, August 19 – Ferguson Flats, August 26 – Mallaig. Water/Sewer – Approximately 4700 metres of pipe has been installed on the Ashmont/Lottie Lake water transmission line. We are also working on a plan to flush the distribution systems at Lottie Lake and Ashmont in anticipation of the completion of the project as well as a plan to upgrade the truckfill in Ashmont.

Work on the Ashmont lagoon expansion project started at the end of June.
