1. CALL TO ORDER:

Irene Van Brabant called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Introduction of Delegations: Glen Brodziak and Angela Hanson

The meeting commenced with our Delegation, Glen Brodziak who shared with Members blue prints of the new Ashmont School with the main focus being upon the Learning Common area.

Members expressed views of their vision as to the location of the Learning Common and how accessible it will be to the general public.

After a thorough discussion, Glen Brodziak asked of the Board to join him on a tour of the Glen Avon School, Learning Common area with hope of getting a better perspective being similar in design to that of the new Ashmont School.

The Board left for a tour of Glen Avon School at 2:45 p.m.

a. New Ashmont School – Learning Common Blue Prints:

From the Board’s discussions earlier with Glen Brodziak, Members conversed over the design of the Learning Common, determining if the Learning Common should have a private entrance or remain as designed, through the main entrance way.

After some discussion, Councillor Laurent Amyotte moved that the Library Board be in agreement with the design of the new Learning Common, with a recorded Vote as noted: For Private Entrance - 5 Against/Opposed - 2. In the absence of Joanne Paquette, another recorded Vote followed for a Closed-In Learning Common area:

For Closed-In Area - 4 Against/Opposed -2

Lorna Conner commented on talks with Jen Anderson, Municipal Affairs with concern to Learning Common with an approximate date of October 15, 2016 before information will be acquired.
