Highlights **July 9, 2019 Council Meeting**

Block Party – FCSS will be hosting a block on July 27 from 12 to 3 pm at Westcove Park. Members of the St. Paul Fire Department will be there to share information on Fire Smart. Representatives from the Ag Service Board, Waste Management, and Planning and Development Departments will be available to answer any questions.

Bylaws – Council gave approved Bylaw 2019-11 to redistrict 140.85 acres in Lot 1, Block 2, Plan 1120579 in NE 30-58-9-W4 from Agricultural to Industrial/Commercial.

Council also gave first reading to Bylaw 2019-19 to amend the Section 2.5 of the Municipal Development Plan to provide a notwithstanding clause, permitting legal access to the development on Lot 1, Block 2, Plan 1120579 (contained within NE 30-58-9-W4) to be created by way of access easement.

Bylaw 2019-18 to amend Section 7.30 of Land Use Bylaw 2013-50 passed first reading. The proposed amendment is a notwithstanding clause for Lot 1, Block 2, Plan 1120579 permitting the installation and operation of a disposal field or treatment mound as soils dictate. The system shall meet the required of the Alberta Private Sewage Systems Standard of Practice Regulation (2015).

Council also approved 2019-12 to amend the Municipal Development Plan and Bylaw 2019-13 to amend the Land Use Bylaw to allow the creation of a 32 acre parcel within the Agriculture District.

Intermunicipal Development Plans – As a requirement resulting from the changes to the Municipal Government Act, all municipalities with common borders must complete and adopt Intermunicipal Development Plans by April 1, 2020. Through funding provided by an Alberta Community Partnership Grant, the County along with the Towns of Elk Point and St. Paul and the Summer Village of Horseshoe Bay have worked with ISL Engineer and Land Services to development the plans. Council gave first reading to Bylaw 2019-15 adopting the Intermunicipal Development Plan with the Town of St. Paul; Bylaw 2019-16 with the Town of Elk Point and Bylaw 2019-17 with the Summer Village of Horseshoe Bay. The draft plans can be viewed on the County Website under Government Resources, Planning and Development, IDPs.

Operational Plan – The second quarter of the 2019 Operation Plan was approved by Council. The plan can be viewed on the County website under Government Resources/Strategic Plan.

Beaver Reduction Incentive Program – The Beaver reduction incentive program ran from April 15 to June 28th. The program will resume for the months of September and October 2019.

Online Credit Card Payment Option – The County has set up a new option to make a payment by credit card – Option Pay. Any Accounts Receivable, Utilities or Property Tax invoice can now be paid through Option Pay. Go to the County Home Page and scroll past the Webmap. Click on the green OptionPay tab and fill in the required information – Tax, Utilities or Other (when paying accounts receivable). Please note there is a fee to use this service, which is calculated on the screen when you enter the payment amount. This fee is paid directly to Option Pay.
