Highlights **September 10, 2019 Council Meeting**

Road Ban on Township Road 590 - There is a 75% Road Ban on TWP 590 from Hwy 36 to Secondary Road 881, which means that only vehicles with a 75% axle rate are permitted on the road. This past summer, the County made significant improvements to this section of TWP 590. Weight in excess of 75% is detrimental to the road and the County would like to preserve this road for as long as possible. The Road Ban will be in effect until frozen road conditions occur and will be in place again as of March 2020.

The County is aware that harvest season is coming up. We would, however, appreciate the cooperation of the public. Information on when the Road Ban will be lifted will be posted on the County's website and Facebook page.

Website - The County of St. Paul has a new Website and staff continue to update the information to enhance the site. If you are searching for information but cannot find it on the website, please contact the County Office.

Year-Round Burn Permits – Just a reminder that year-round burn permits are required for all types of open burning. Permits are issued for 10 days at a time and can be obtained by contacting the County Office. Residents are reminded that there is a \$450 fine to burn without a permit.

LRA Rodeo Supper – The County served 830 plates at the rodeo supper. Proceeds from the supper went to the Mallaig and Ag Society.

MLA David Hanson met with Council to discuss several items including upgrading of local highways, mowing and weed control along local highways and funding for 2019 STIP and MSI Grants. Council also discussed the Red Tape Reduction Act. Administration will be preparing a submission on repairing and maintaining existing boat launches, water act approvals and First Nations Consultations when upgrading roads.
