PW-15 Erecting Cautionary Signs Policy

Department: Public Works

POLICY OBJECTIVE:

The County of St. Paul desires to provide and erect signage advising motorists of the need to proceed with caution when children or facilities for children are in the immediate area.

POLICY STATEMENTS:

1.0 Children at Play

- 1.1 "Playground" and "Children Playing" cautionary signs shall be available for placement along County roads for residents with children in the following situations:
 - (a) Along thoroughfare roads which pass through Hamlets;
 - (b) Municipal Parks:
 - (c) Residential subdivisions (at the entrance); and
 - (d) Playgrounds.

2.0 School Bus

2.1 School Bus" signs may be available at residences if requested by the St. Paul Regional Education.

3.0 Industry

3.1 Industry signs such as "no oil field traffic" may be placed in a County right-of-way if requested, approved and paid for by industry. Industry will need to make a request to County Council for the placement of industry signs along County rights-of-way as restriction of travel along a County roadway may or may not be allowed.
