DEV-5 Recreation Corridor Designation Policy

Department: Planning and Development

POLICY OBJECTIVE:

The County of St. Paul recognizes the benefits of recreational corridors within the municipality. Recreational corridors encourage physical activity, enhance environmental awareness, provide opportunities for rural diversification, economic development and tourism promotion.

The County of St. Paul desires to create a designation process for municipally significant recreation corridors to support the orderly, balanced, and well-managed growth of the provincial and municipal trail network while maximizing benefits to all stakeholders.

POLICY STATEMENTS:

1.0 Requests

- 1.1 Any incorporated society, registered association, or non-profit entity wishing to designate a recreational corridor with the County of St. Paul No. 19 must obtain agreements with all adjacent landowners, or easements, if a corridor enters onto private land.
- 1.2 Upon receipt of the necessary agreements or easements, the group may bring forward their request to the County of St. Paul No. 19 for Council's consideration.
- 1.3 Municipal designations correspond with municipal legislation only. If provincial designation is desired, the group must meet the requirements set out at the provincial level.
