## County of St. Paul Members-at-Large

### County Library Board

The County is looking for five residents to serve as a member-at-large on the County of St. Paul Library Board. The Board Members will sit on the board along with two Elected Officials. The board provides financial management and policy direction for County Libraries, being the Ashmont and Mallaig Public Libraries. Meetings are held monthly except during the months of July and August. Board members can also attend meetings via zoom during this time.

The board member will be elected for a three-year term as per Section 4(5) of the Libraries Act. Members at large will be paid a per diem as well as mileage to attend meetings.

### Regional Assessment Review Board

The County is seeking one resident to serve on the Regional Assessment Review Board. This board is called upon only when a ratepayer files an assessment complaint that has not been resolved by the County assessors. Members are trained for the Local Assessment Review Board (LARB) as well as the Composite Assessment Review Board (CARB) at a 4-day course hosted by Municipal Affairs and 2-day refresher course every three years thereafter. Training will be provided.
